Sooner or later almost all parents will go on the road for a long road trip. From toddlers to teens, almost all teenagers get bored and frustrated after an hour or so in the car. And let's face it, there's only so much I-Spy with my little eye and word association games parents can manage before they're left feeling drained and ready for some distraction. In-car DVD players from retailers like Currys, Tesco, Sainsbury's and Amazon provide a simple and affordable solution in our digital media age. Personally, I don't believe that DVDs are going anywhere quickly. Sure, streaming is off platforms like Netflix and Amazon Prime and on the rise, but most families carry a decent DVD collection to choose from for a long journey. And, movie streaming services will always rely on mobile data signals (have you ever driven Brecken Beacons?) while DVDs can be played wherever you are. Below are two in-car DVD player reviews. You may be surprised at how affordable in-car DVD players are in 2016/2017 and beyond, but be sure to think about the features you need before you make a purchase. Voyager 7 inch Dual In Car Portable DVD Player with Easy Fit Mount Important, to provide the Voyager model you buy includes the ability to play more than one movie on both screens (one listed below includes separate screen usage, so you should be fine.) Although this model is a little more expensive than the PM model, it is the only device you want if your young will be different ages. Have you ever seen a 12-year-old watch Peppa Pig with your younger brother? (Well done, if you have.) I would say that Voyager 7 is not the most intuitive in-car DVD player as some of the features are pretty simplistic. For example, there are four main controls located around the central ring with buttons to move the playback of the film forward/back, up and down. However, these types of management are easy for the young to manage, and I think it's part of the design features that support easy usability. A great feature of the DVD player is the montage, which is very quick and easy to set up. The device is powered by a standard 12V phone/cigarette socket that you can find in almost any UK car. Once you are powered up the second screen is easily turned on by running the cable from one screen to the other. Note you can get a little frustrated keeping the wires neat so a simple hairband can be extremely helpful. The image quality is 480x234 pixels. So not a crystal clear picture of HD quality, but definitely acceptable for young under-14s I would say. A good feature is auto-resume features that allow your kids to continue to look from where. The device's speakers are built in and are ideal for children who are too young to wear headphones. Older children will enjoy headphones and the ability to connect wireless headphones (note, wireless headphones are not included in This device also includes USB and SD slots and the player supports the usual file formats, including MP3 and JPEG. Finally, both screens have their own remotes! That's a good bonus. With a small search on Tesco, Currys and Sainsbury's websites I found this device cheaper on Amazon.co.uk. Their offer at a discount: Voyager 7 Double DVD Player was 149.99 pounds, but is now on offer at 102.95 pounds. DBPOWER 9.5 Portable DVD Player This portable DVD player is available from Tesco, Currys, Sainsbury's and Amazon. This device looks, feels and acts quite differently than the Voyager 7 listed above. Keep in mind that this DVD player is a little heavier than average, mainly due to the polymer lithium battery, which promises 5 hours of continuous play. Extended playing time is a big feature and, in my opinion, overcomes the lack of weight. Not many features, but more need is the SD card slot and USB port to make the movie play without DVD and game. Again, these adaptations are common to any reasonable in-car DVD player. The DB 9.5 is a large screen size, but I found the buttons and navigation features to be a bit clunky. Also, the general feeling of this player is somehow cumbersome and a little difficult to manage. Not to say I don't like the machine, but it's not a seamless experience to use. However, for a fine price, I think we can't complain. As with most portable DVD players, you'll find CD, MP3, DVD, JPEG compatibility. Perhaps my favorite feature is the 360-degree rotary function so it can be used in the style of a TV or a table of vision to help improve visibility. The headphone port is also included in this model. The MP4 note is supported, but only at 480x320. The game controller and car charger are on. Overall I like this portable DVD player because the picture is crispy, features easy to use and the volume plays louder than I expected (which can be an important feature if your car carries a lot of noise on the road! This portable DVD player requires 12 hours of charging before the full use of 5 hours can be enjoyed.
